Dear Friends of Kalama,

Envision Kalama had a productive 2014! Your contributions along with our activities provided funding for important projects in our community. Thank you for your generous support.

We will continue “Contributing to Kalama’s Future” in 2015. Here are the priority projects for Envision Kalama:

The Community Building continues to be the venue for all of our events and celebrations. It needs upgrades to the wiring and the retaining walls. Installing energy efficient measures will save money on maintenance costs. Local monies are required to match grant funds currently available to cities making energy-saving upgrades to public buildings. **Contributions to Envision Kalama earmarked for the “Community Building” will help fund these improvements in partnership with the City and other Kalama civic groups.**

The proceeds from our 7th annual Word Catcher 2015 are earmarked for the Kalama Library. Along with the City and the Friends of the Library in Kalama (FOLK), your donations keep the Library the cornerstone of our community, making it possible to expand and enhance programs and services. **Your contributions to “Word Catcher “ will provide stipends for authors and presenters, increasing the net proceeds to go directly to the Library Fund.**

Beginning in 2008, the Kalama Streetscape Project provided trees, plantings and landscaping along all of First Street in downtown Kalama. The community generously purchased forty-one trees with a commemorative plaque for each tree. There are only eleven trees and plaques left for purchase. Your contribution earmarked “Kalama Streetscape Project” will enhance the existing landscape. **A \$550 contribution will buy you one of the remaining commemorative trees and a plaque.**

Contributions will fund other projects and activities in 2015.
