ORDINANCE NO. 1370

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KALAMA, WASHINGTON AMENDING THE KALAMA MUNICIPAL CODE CHAPTER 2.08.020 MAYOR'S AND COUNCILMEMBER'S SALARIES, INCREASING THE SALARY OF THE MAYOR

WHEREAS, the business of the City of Kalama has increased dramatically and continues to require more time of the Mayor on a daily basis and in representing the City at various other meetings and functions;

NOW THEREFORE the City Council of the City of Kalama do ordain as follows:

Section 1. Kalama Municipal Code section 2.08.020 is amended as follows:

2.08.020 Mayor's and councilmembers' salaries.

A. The mayor's salary shall be increased to the sum of five seven hundred (\$500) (\$700) dollars per month and will become effective with the payroll for January 2016.

B. Councilmembers attendance fees shall be modified to one hundred (\$100) dollars per meeting, not to exceed two hundred (\$200) per month.

C. These increases for the City Council shall become effective at the next election for the various positions as provided by state law.

Section 2. Severability. If any section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase of this ordinance is declared unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining parts of this ordinance.

Section 3. This ordinance shall become effective five days after passage, approval, and publication as provided by law. Passed by the City Council of the City of Kalama at a regular meeting held on the <u>2nd</u> of <u>December</u>, 2015.
