CITY OF KALAMA PLANNING COMMISSION AUGUST 13, 2015

OPENING

Chairman Patrick Harbison opened the meeting at 6:00 p.m. Commissioners present were Dan Ohall, Phillip Fortuna, Kevin Wade, and Kimberly Sullivan. Commissioners absent were Jim Hendrickson and Don Mathison. Staff present were City Planner Matt Buchanan, City Administrator Adam Smee and Secretary Susan Junnikkala.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

1. Comprehensive Plan Update

Chairperson Harbison asked Planner Buchanan if he would give a review on the existing condition for the Comprehensive Plan (comp. plan).

Planner Buchanan gave an outline of his progress with the comp. plan so far. The following is what was discussed:

PURPOSE

The purpose of this memo is to provide updated information on the existing conditions within the city of Kalama and it's Urban Growth Boundary (UGB), which serves as the planning area. Examining the existing conditions is an important early step in the process of updating a comprehensive plan. In order to establish the policies which will guide the community toward achieving our vision, we must first understand where we are today. When we can understand both our existing conditions as well as our vision, we can then perform an in depth analysis, identify gaps, and assess community needs.

The other areas that were reviewed were land use, vacancy, population and demographics and vacant housing over the years. Planner Buchanan also presented to the Commission a timeline of activities and accomplishments to the Commission. Chairperson Harbison thanked Planner Buchanan for all his hard work.

2. Visual Preference Survey – Update

Planner Buchanan presented to the Commission a vision exercise for the Comp. Plan. This is the exercise that he wants to present at the meeting that will be held at the community building with the public. The questions are:
