Pursuant to Kalama Municipal Code (KMC) 15.10.040, City planning staff has reviewed each of these materials, and hereby deems your application complete for the following permits:

The determination of completeness does not preclude the City from requesting additional information or studies if needed at a future date in order to issue the final decision.

Pursuant to KMC 15.10.070, the city shall provide a notice of SSDP application and SEPA determination to the public within 14 days after the determination of completeness. In accordance with Washington Administrative Code (WAC) 173-27-110, the public comment process period shall be not less than 30 days following the date of notice of application.
