

ORDINANCE NO 1399

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KALAMA AMENDING KALAMA MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 12.12.010 TO INCLUDE A BASE RATE FOR AN 8-INCH METER FOR COMMERCIAL WATER USERS.

WHEREAS, the City of Kalama adopted Ordinance No. 1368 in December of 2015 adopting a five-tier rate increase for all water users;

WHEREAS, the City of Kalama has received a request to install a new 8-inch meter for an industrial customer;

WHEREAS, the City of Kalama finds the base rate for an 8-inch meter is not included in the current rates as adopted by Ordinance 1368 and needs to added;

NOW THEREFORE the City Council of the City of Kalama do ordain as follows:

SECTION 1: Kalama Municipal Code Section 12.12.010 is hereby amended to read as follows:

12.12.010 Monthly rates and charges for water

A. The monthly rates and charges for water furnished inside the city limits to all users are fixed as follows:

1) The volume charge or per 100 Cubic Foot rate for all users:

B. For all usage over three hundred fifty thousand cubic feet per month up to two million cubic feet per month qualifying industrial customers will pay the following:

No user shall be entitled to use more than two million cubic feet per month, unless such capacity exists and is readily available in the water system. A qualifying user is defined as a customer who has negotiated and paid an agreed upon financial contribution with the City based upon its maximum usage capacity, for capital improvements to the water system, treatment costs or future maintenance costs. **By 2020 the City will no longer offer a declining rate structure to qualified users and the consumption rate will be the same for all consumer usage.**

C. **Outside Water Rates**

1) All charges for water services provided to residential and multi-family residential customers outside the Kalama City limits shall be set at a rate of 185% of the charges for water services within the Kalama City limits.

2) All charges for water services provided to commercial and industrial customers outside the Kalama City limits shall be set at a rate of 150% of the charges for water services within the Kalama City limits

D. Any existing structure having mixed uses and serviced by only one meter shall be classified and charged at the higher applicable meter fee. Any new structures shall be required to meter each classification of usage separately.

E. The base meter fee for water service provided to all manufactured home parks or housing development with multi-family units serviced through a master meter shall be computed on the single or multi-family dwellings with the meter fee computed as if each individual unit were metered separately.

F. The use of fire hydrants and standpipes connected to the city water system for other than fire prevention purposes shall be by special permit obtained from the department of public works Any individual, firm, company, contractor, corporation, or other entity, withdrawing water from city water hydrants and standpipes, prior to first withdrawing such water, shall obtain a permit therefor from the city clerk-treasurer at the cost as set by resolution of the City Council which shall allow the permittee to withdraw up to 5000 gallons of water under such permit at no additional charge. Additional water may be withdrawn under such permit for the payment of all such additional water at a rate as set by resolution of the City Council. All applicants for such permit shall receive written instructions on fire hydrant use and shall be required, as part of the permit process, to agree to comply with such instructions or be held accountable therefor for any damage to city property.

SECTION 2: Acts consistent with this ordinance, but prior to its effective date, are hereby ratified and confirmed.

SECTION 3: Severability. If any section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase of this ordinance is declared unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining parts of this ordinance.
