RESOLUTION NO. 671

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF KALAMA, COWLITZ COUNTY, WASHINGTON, AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 660 SETTING FEES FOR BUILDING PERMITS AND RELATED MATTERS AS OF JANUARY 2018 TO INCORPORATE THE CHANGES IN THE STATE FEES AS OF JULY 1, 2018

WHEREAS the City Council adopted Resolution No. 660 on December 6, 2017 setting the building fees for 2018;

WHEREAS, the Governor signed HB 1622 modifying the fees for the State Building Code Council effective July 1, 2018;

NOW THEREFORE be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Kalama Resolution No. 660 is amended as follows:

SECTION 1: Building Permit Fees. Fees for building permits are due at the time of permit issuance and shall be calculated according to the table below:

SECTION 2: Plan Review Fee. The fee for reviewing plans for building permits is 65 percent of the building permit fee paid at the time of plan submittal. If an applicant submits all at the same time, plans for identical buildings for one or two-family dwellings under the International Residential Code, the plan review fee shall be 50 percent of the

plan review fee for the first one submitted. These fees are in addition to the permit fees in Section 1.

SECTION 3: Plumbing Permit Fees. The fees for plumbing and gas piping permits include both a permit issuance fee and a unit fee. The fees are calculated according to the table below:

Section 9. Washington State Building Code Surcharge

For Each Building Permit – Projects permitted under the IBC or IEBC: \$4.50 \$25.00

For Residential Multi-Unit Structures-Projects permitted under the IRC: \$4.50 \$6.50 for each Permit issued PLUS \$2.00 per Dwelling additional Unit after the first.
