## A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KALAMA AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 659 RELATING TO FEES AND CHARGES IMPOSED BY THE CITY OF KALAMA BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2018, ADDING THE NEWLY ADOPTED FEE FOR SIDEWALKS
