## **GOVENOR ORDERS "STAY HOME - STAY HEALTHY"**

As of March 26, 2020, Washingtonians have been ordered to stay home unless they work in an essential occupation, such as health care, first responders, grocery clerks, and public utilities or have to go out for an essential need such as groceries or a medical appointment. This order is in place for at least two weeks until April 9th, but may be extended if the virus continues to spread. It is vitally important that all citizens adhere to the order to curb the spread of the virus, so we can stay healthy. The sooner the virus begins to decline, the sooner the end of shutdowns and restrictions can be lifted. You can go outside, the restriction is not to your home, but to avoid contact with others to avoid possible contamination. Social distancing of at least 6 feet is necessary even during outside activities such as walking or riding bikes. So, let's all do our part and STAY HOME – STAY HEALTHY!!



While COVID-19 may be interrupting your regular routine, it is important to:

- Get fresh air and daylight—open up your blinds, curtains, and/or windows.
- Keep some of your same routine elements—make your bed, get up at your regular time, shower and get dressed.
- Eat your regular meals.

# **CORONAVIRUS - OPEN/CLOSED?**

In response to the outbreak, all schools have been closed until April 24<sup>th</sup> and restaurants are closed except for takeout and drive through services by order of the Governor. Grocery stores, pharmacies and other retailers are open. Banks and other service-oriented businesses are providing limited services while some retail/service businesses have closed temporally. Gym and indoor recreation facilities are closed. Service providers such as beauticians, barbers, and nail technicians have been closed, while many health care facilities such as dentists or eye doctors are open for emergency services only. City water and sewer services are operating as normal, even though offices are closed to the public. Waste Control is continuing services on the regular schedule. Any changes will be announced and posted as soon as possible. Police are operating on the normal 24/7 schedule. Kalama Public Library is closed. All Parks and Recreation activities at the Community Building have been suspended.



Schools are providing breakfast and sack lunches for children (0-18) during this time which are available for pickup weekdays between 11 am and 12:30 pm in the covered area in the parking lot. There are no charges for these lunches, only that a child be present.

During this crisis, we are all using more cleaning supplies including sanitizing wipes and paper towels, but these items including wipes labeled as "flushable" should **NOT!!!** be flushed down your toilets. These items create clogs and backups to the sewer lines,

pump stations and the sewer plant. Please, if it isn't #1 or #2 or toilet paper, don't flush it. Thank you.
