Name of Proposal: Lower Green Mountain Reservoir and Booster Pump Station

Description of Proposal: The proposed project will construct a 120,000 gallon reservoir, 35 gallon per minute (gpm) water pumping station in a 10'x12' CMU building with dark green, metal roofing.

Location of Proposal: The reservoir and booster station will be located at the intersection of Green Mountain Road and Thompson Road. The property is located in Section 27, Township 6 North, Range 1 West. Cowlitz County Assessor Parcel Number WC2702010.


