

NOTICE OF APPLICATION (NOA)

REQUEST FOR COMMENTS ON SHORELINE SUBSTANTIAL DEVELOPMENT (SSDP) PERMIT and SITE PLAN REVIEW

Pursuant to KMC 15.10.070, RCW 90.58.140 and WAC 173-27-110, NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Port of Kalama has filed an application for the following described project. The permit applications and listed studies are available for public review at the KALAMA CLERK-TREASURER, 195 N FIRST ST, KALAMA, WA 98625 between the hours of 9:00 AM to 5:00PM, Monday through Friday, except holidays.

Proposal: Construct Small Vessel Dock, pedestrian pathway improvements, pathway lighting, and tour bus parking area improvements in the Port of Kalama's Marine Park.

Location: The project is located in Township 6N, Range 1W, Sections 17 and 18 on a portion of two tax lots including 24.1 acres of property on Tax Lot Number 41056, located at 280 West Marine Drive and Tax Lot Number 412640100 located at 215 Hendrickson Drive.
