Summer Sewer Averaging is Ending Soon

Public works will be doing water meter readings around September 18th, so the summer sewer averaging for utility bills that have sewer charges will end on that date. This means any water usage after September 18th will have a sewer charge associated with each drop of water used. To avoid an unexpectedly high bill, please reduce your watering activities—reduce sprinkler usage, filling pools, washing cars, pressure washing, etc.



Reminder: Summer Sewer Averaging is effective from the middle of May to the middle of September. Outside of that, every drop of water has a sewer charge that goes with it. Water is metered at the meter, not when it goes down a drain. More details can be found on the city's website: www.cityofkalama.com
