Don't Bring: Material from businesses (including farms, schools, and churches), unlabeled products,

empty paint cans or containers, leaking containers, items larger than 5 gallons or 50 pounds, explosives, ammunition, radioactive material, biological/infectious material, or

hypodermic needles.

Limit: Volume cannot exceed 25 gallons or 200 pounds without prior approval.

• Keep material in original container

- Store material so it will not tip or spill during transport
- Don't transport material in passenger compartment of vehicle
- Don't bring children or pets
- No smoking while on site

If you cannot attend this free collection event, save your material for the next mobile event or take to the Permanent Collection Facility located at the Waste Control Transfer Station, $1150\ 3^{rd}$ Avenue, Longview, open every Tuesday and Saturday, $9:30\ a.m.-11:30\ a.m.$
