City Hall Renovations

The staff is thrilled to have Council's approval to start the renovations at City Hall (195 N. First Street)! Construction will begin on June 3rd, and access to staff will look a little different. Temporary offices will be set up for utility payments, the building department, and other needs requiring **in person contact at 320 N. First -the Library building- where city hall used to be located** before 2016. Two staff members will be present daily to serve our customers in person from 9am-5pm with the office closed from 12pm to 1pm for lunch. As always, **payments** can be mailed by US Postal Service to: City of Kalama, P.O. Box 1007, Kalama, WA 98625. Drop box payments can be made at 195 N. First St (green box), but online payments are strongly encouraged. For online payments, visit: https://tinyurl.com/2hwct9eu

Other staff members will will be working in other city locations or from home and available by phone or email for appointments. You can still call city office(s) at the same phone numbers listed in the staff directory on the city website at www.cityofkalama.com. Notary services will be provided by appointment only during this construction period.

The renovation of the City Hall space will provide professional and efficient office space, to meet the current and future staffing needs of the growing community. When the building was purchased, the City made very minimal improvements to the interior before moving into the facility, after the flood of 2015, and even utilized the existing bank furnishings that were left behind. The current bank configuration is not efficient for the many department functions that are performed by city staff. The staff has worked diligently during the design process to keep costs low while working to meet the current and future staffing levels to best serve the community.

City Hall staff will do their best to be accessible during this transition time. We thank you in advance for your flexibility and look forward to serving the community with a more efficient space. The project is expected to take from 4 to 6 months, and we hope to be back in our fresh new space in November 2024!

Juneteenth: Offices & Library Closed


