Back to School Safety

It's that time of year: students are back to school! Whether you have a little Chinook of your own or you drive through the Kalama school zones during your day-- please use caution in these areas. Drivers: slow down and be alert!

<u>Pedestrian Safety</u>

- •Crosswalks: Always use designated crosswalks and obey crossing guards.
- •Visibility: Make eye contact with drivers before crossing.
- •Sidewalks: Walk on sidewalks where available; if not, walk facing traffic.

School Bus Safety

- •Bus Stops: Arrive early at the bus stop and wait in a safe location away from the road.
- •Boarding/Exiting: Wait for the bus to stop completely before getting on or off, and cross the street in front of the bus only when the driver signals it's safe.
- •Behavior: Stay seated, keep noise to a minimum, and follow the driver's instructions.

Distracted Driving

- •Focus: Keep your eyes on the road and avoid distractions such as texting or eating.
- •Speed: Slow down in school zones and be prepared for sudden stops.
- •Awareness: Watch for children walking, biking, or getting on and off school buses.

Let's all do our part to create a safe environment for our students as they head back to school. Stay alert, stay safe!



Storytime @ the Library


