### **Trick-or-Treat Safety**

Here are some essential tips to make this Halloween both enjoyable and safe:

- Costume safety: Choose bright colors, reflective tape, glow sticks, and/or flashlights.
- Street safety: Use crosswalks, stay in groups, and watch for vehicles.
- Candy inspection: Check candy before consuming, and discard anything suspicious.
- Driver awareness: Drive slowly, slow down in residential areas, and keep an eye out for trick-or-treaters who may not look both ways. Give your full attention while driving.
- Safety apps/tech: Consider using family tracking apps to monitor children's location while they're out trick-or-treating. Ensure that children have a way to contact an adult if they get lost. Equip them with a phone or write down important phone numbers.


