City Planner Hermen presented to the Commission a new revised code section 17.23 Small Lot Single-Family Floating Zone (SL-SF). Planner Hermen reviewed the proposed code changes.

Commissioner Ohall inquired if this proposal addresses fire access concerns. Planner Hermen mentioned that the City has adopted the International Fire Code, which sets provisions for safety and access. Commissioner Ohall also asked about fences, relating to the type and impedance of existing utility lines. Commissioner Ohall was informed that as far as fences and when they start to deteriorate than that would be handled with a nuisance letter. If there were water and sewer lines between two homes there would be an easement in place and the City has the rights to remove any structure that may be in the way.

The Commission made suggestion to some word changes in the rest of section 17.23.
