

RESOLUTION NO. 611

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KALAMA REPLACING AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 600 RELATING TO 2014 FEES AND CHARGES IMPOSED BY THE CITY OF KALAMA AND ESTABLISHING THE FOLLOWING FEES AND CHARGES FOR THE SERVICES SET FORTH HEREIN.

WHEREAS, the City of Kalama provides services in many areas for which they charge fees to the public and;

WHEREAS, the City of Kalama reviews such fees on an annual basis in conjunction with the annual budget;

WHEREAS, the City of Kalama finds it necessary to amend the 2014 fee schedule to address fees not previously included and clarify other fees;
